### **Subject: Request for Clarification Regarding Officer Visit on 2/26/2026**

Dear Chief,

I am writing to request written clarification regarding an interaction I had with one of your officers at my apartment on **February 26, 2026**.

The officer informed me that I was “being evicted” and told me to “stop sending them emails.” I was confused because I have been communicating with my landlord’s corporate management company regarding ongoing housing issues over the past several months. My emails were sent to multiple company addresses and were limited to maintenance concerns, code compliance matters, and documentation relevant to my housing situation. None of my messages contained threats.

When I showed the officer the emails the company had sent to me, as well as my replies, he told me, “Do not talk to them,” but did not identify who “them” referred to. Because the company uses multiple email addresses and various staff members communicate with me, I am unclear who I am being told not to contact.

I want to clarify the following:

- I have not threatened any individual.
- All of my communications relate to housing issues.
- I have not been served with a Personal Protection Order (PPO), a no-contact order, or any court directive restricting communication.
- I received a form from the company, and when I asked questions about it, the officer stated that I should not reply, even though the form required a response.

The officer also told me that if I emailed “them” again, he would “come back and arrest” me, and at one point said, “Do you want me to take your computer?” This left me unsure what legal basis applied. I am not aware of any law that prohibits me from sending emails to my landlord’s company, especially when responding to messages they sent to me.

To ensure I comply with all lawful requirements, I respectfully request clarification of:

1. Whether there is a specific individual I am legally restricted from contacting.
2. If so, who that individual is.
3. Whether there is any court order, written directive, or PPO that applies to my communications.
4. Whether the instruction to avoid replying to the company's emails was based on a misunderstanding.

I want to follow all lawful instructions, but without written information identifying who I must avoid contacting—or the legal basis for such a restriction—I do not know how to proceed.

I would appreciate written clarification for my records. Thank you for taking the time to review this matter.
